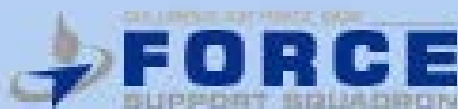

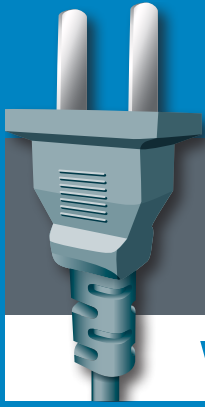
For All Emergencies Dial 911



- Dialing **911** from ANY VoIP goes **DIRECTLY** to CAFB FES Dispatch Center
 - Dialing **911** from **ANY** mobile device goes to Lowndes County Dispatch Center – State you are on CAFB to have them reroute the call to CAFB FES Dispatch Center
 - State your **Emergency** – Fire, Medical, Vehicle Accident, Smell of Smoke, etc.
 - State your **Building Number** and **Room Number OR Area** you are calling from
 - **Follow** the Dispatchers direction and prompts – **DO NOT** argue, **DO NOT** ask to speak to a Supervisor
 - **DO NOT** report an Emergency via the CAFB FES Admin Line – if in doubt **DIAL 911**
 - If fire is suspected **ACTIVATE** the facility alarm system if available – **RED** pull handle located near exits
-
- **EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY** and report to your facilities designated **RALLY** or **COLLECTION POINT**
 - **DON'T KNOW WHERE YOUR FACILITIES RALLY POINT IS?**– Speak to your designated Facility Manager **ASAP**
 - **PERFORM ACCOUNTABILITY** once at Rally Point and **REPORT** number to arriving FES Crews
 - **STAY CALM** and follow CAFB FES Crew prompts

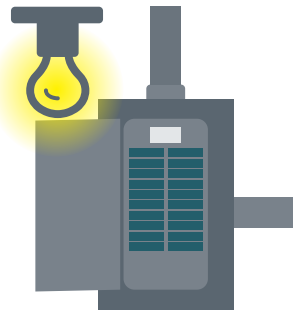

There are approximately **45,000** home electrical fires each year.



Half of all home electrical fires involve home wiring or lighting equipment.

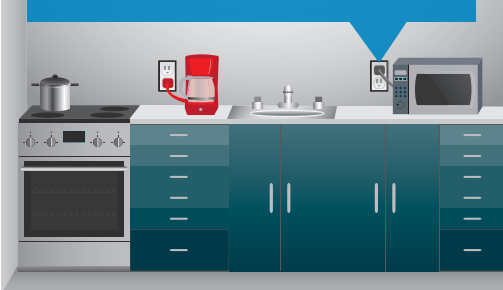


Home electrical fire deaths peak between **midnight and 8 a.m.**

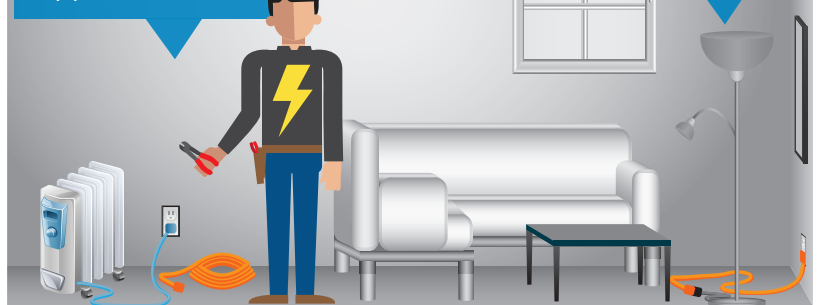


Peak months for electrical fire deaths are **November through March.**

Plug only 1 heat-producing appliance (like a coffee maker, space heater or microwave) directly into a wall outlet at a time.



Never use an extension cord with a heat-producing appliance.



Extension cords should only be used temporarily. Have an electrician install additional wall outlets where you need them.

For scheduling 1st and 2nd Dose Appointments:

1. Select appropriate appointment *“Initial Dose/Second Dose”*
2. Select appropriate date
3. Select appointment slot
4. Fill all required text boxes
5. Select *“Submit Request”*
6. Read all text on the page
7. Select *“Home”*
8. Select *“Next”*
9. Select *“Second Dose”*
10. Select appropriate vaccine brand *“Moderna”* and enter *“Date of first vaccine”*
11. Select *“Next”* x2
12. Select appropriate date
13. Select appointment slot
14. Fill all required text boxes
15. Select *“Submit Request”*
16. Exit the COVAX Tool



For Scheduling 2nd Dose Appointments:

1. Select appropriate appointment *“Second Dose”*
2. Select appropriate vaccine brand *“Moderna”* and enter appropriate date
3. Select appointment slot
4. Fill all required text boxes
5. Select *“Submit Request”*
6. Exit the COVAX Tool
